High Standard used this code on the rifles and shotguns first.

I have not determined when the first pistols were date coded. Based on present observations, it appears that date coding of pistol frames started during the 103 series and later during the 104 and 106 series, this marking location was moved to the bottom of the barrel.

At some point High Standard appears to have stopped using this system for pistols. In checking a few guns I find barrels marked as late as GS on a Supermatic Citation s/n 2,448,511

I did not find one on a Sport King s/n 2,456,134 My guess is that the transition was about this point in time, Mid 1974
